Review of Discipleship group study on Not Beyond Reach

Our discipleship groups just completed a series called *Not Beyond Reach*. We learned ways to be more effective in reaching the lost in a post Christian culture. In keeping with our church's mission, *making disciples who grow, serve, and witness through word and action*, we need to apply what we have learned. Whether you were a part of one of our groups or not, I'd like to share some key takeaways that can help us be more effective disciple makers.

1. Learn the culture you are trying to reach. This requires a listening posture.
2. Ask God to break your heart for the lost and to provide opportunities for you to connect with lost people.
3. Build friendships with non-believers.
4. Live as faithful witnesses—present yet distinct.
5. Initiate spiritual conversations; asking the Spirit to first help you discern their idols, felt needs, lies they believe, as well as true things that you can affirm.
6. Look for ways to bridge spiritual conversations to Jesus and the Gospel.
7. Expect opposition while trusting in God's power.
8. Prepare a short personal testimony and invite others to respond to Jesus.
9. Win hearts not arguments when cultural topics come up, redirecting debates toward Jesus.
10. Submit your own life fully to Christ
