Leviticus 16:7-22 describes how, on the day of Atonement, the high priest was to take two goats and present them before the LORD. One goat was killed as a sin offering, making atonement for the people's sin. The priest then laid hands on the live goat, the scapegoat, and sent it into the wilderness, carrying the people's sins away.

In Isaiah 53:5, is a prophecy concerning Jesus describing him as one pierced for our transgressions and crushed for our iniquities. Yet Isaiah's prophecy also depicts him as the scapegoat. In Isaiah 53:4 Jesus is described as bearing our griefs and carrying our sorrows; in 53:3, Jesus as despised and rejected by men.

John the Baptist said of Jesus at his baptism, "Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world. Thomas Torrance describes this event as Jesus "vicariously baptized into repentance and consecrated as the Lamb of God to bear away the sin of the world." For after this, Jesus was led by the Spirit alone into the desert, "under the burden of our sin."

Going back to Leviticus 16:16, atonement was made for the Holy Place, because of the sin of the people. This was so the people could enter the tent of meeting where the LORD would dwell. From the fall in Genesis 3 onward, God began his plan to redeem mankind to himself, so he could be present with us.

In 1 Corinthians 6:19, our bodies are described as temples of the Holy Spirit and in 3:9 that the believers together are God's building. Duvall and Hays say that God's people "are not simply allowed to enter the holy of holies, but they themselves are now the holy of holies. God now dwells among his people."

We are now weeks removed from celebrating Christ's death and resurrection during the Easter season. Yet, the focus of Easter is still the center of our faith. We are still reconciled to God, and we get to be in God's presence every day!

The reconciliation between us and God is not a state of feeling guilty and bad all the time, like the expression "I'm just a sinner saved by grace" implies, all the while being thankful that our sins were paid for. Rather, the reconciliation between us and God is one of being clothed in Christ's righteousness with our identity now as saint, not sinner. Though we still sin and stumble in many ways, our identity as believers is no longer sinner. We can now draw near the throne of grace with confidence. Jesus was both the perfect sacrifice and the Lamb of God who took away the sin of the world.

We pray that this special time of monthly prayer together will help us see what God wants us to do as a church and build unity in and through our church members.


